Eglwys Sant Pedr - codwyd corff yr eglwys yn C15 a'r gangell yn C16, cynllun hirsgwar syml gyda phorth agored cain mewn derw, mae wedi'i restru'n gradd II*.

St Peter's Church - the nave was built in the C15

and the chancel in the C16 forming a simple rectangular plan with a fine open oak porch, grade II* listed.

B

Meini Hirion - dau faen, un dros 3m o uchder. Gan mai'r Afon Artro yw'r unig afon agored yn Ardudwy, tybier mai nodi glanfa cynhanesyddol oedd rhain.



Standing Stones - as the River Artro is the only navigable river in Ardudwy, it is thought these stones denoted a prehistoric landing place - one stone is over three metres tall.

C

Clawdd Llanw - adeiladwyd y cloddiau gan Syr Thomas Mostyn ar ddechrau'r C19 i gorlannu'r afon ac adennill tir.

Tidal embankment - built in early C19 by Sir Thomas Mostyn to channel the river and reclaim land.

D

Pont y Coroni - adeiladwyd i ddathlu coroni Sior Ved ym 1911, adnewyddwyd y bont yn 2010.

Coronation Bridge - built to celebrate George V's coronation in 1911, the current bridge replaced the old one in 2010.



E

Cei Pensarn - codwyd yn 1820au i allforio llechi o chwareli yn Llanbedr a Llanfair, hefyd i fewnforio coed a chalch.

Pensarn Quay - the quay was built in the 1820s to export slates from Llanbedr and Llanfair quarries, and to import timber and lime.



F

Cored Bysgota - codwyd nifer o'r argaeau bychain yma i ffurfio pyllau pysgota yn y C19 pan oedd Llanbedr yn ganolfan bysgota boblogaidd . Codwyd nifer o'r tai mawrion ynghanol y pentref fel lletyau ar gyfer pysgotwyr ac ymwelwyr.

Fishing Weir - many of these low dams were built in the C19 to form fishing pools when Llanbedr became a popular fishing centre. Many of the large houses in the village served as accommodation for fishermen and visitors.

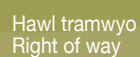
