

## Draft of minutes of Community Council Meeting 5.7.23

### 2 Apologies

One declaration an interest in a planning application

2 planning applications (discussing both, but commenting on 1 of them – namely Application NP5/62/116E which is to remove a stone wall to the existing balcony and replace it with black, steel railings. Cysgod y Coed, Llanbedr.

The Council had no objection to this.

Cemetery work – boundary wall – gap in the wall has been built..

Some gravestones not safe. Family notified.

Sprayed thorns and ivy here.

Again, some families plant flowers on the grave plot. This is not allowed. It is kindly requested once more for everyone to try to keep the graves tidy.

Paths – Work will be carried out on path 23 and path 8 by Gwynedd Council.

John Williams will start cutting the paths.

Annwen Hughes has asked Gwynedd Council for New Stiles on routes 48 and 38.

Notified Natural Resources Wales of the poor condition of the tidal bank – part of a coastal path.

Cae Chwarae/Cae Deiliog – that a grant has been received for the purchase of a bench – picnic table for Cae Deiliog. Will be placed on site soon.

The hedge between playground and land near the river needs tidying up. Cut the height, and trim in about 2 feet. This will be done in the Autumn – biodiversity rules.

Finally – there was a meeting with Gwynedd Council officers and Transport for Wales and Government officials regarding the way forward with the New road and quick fix plans to alleviate the traffic problem in Llanbedr and ensure road safety. Gwynedd Council has received £300,000 for Initial Work. The first view is to have in place a Project Manager. Hopefully this will be done soon.
