A word from the Chairman - inviting everyone to the meeting, on a very nice evening for a change..

Meeting at 7.00 to try to see how to operate the microphone, and also borrowed one from the Library in Harlech. This again, did not work.

Declaration of interest - none

Planning Applications - nothing new.

The Clerk noted that there was demolition work on buildings at the dog kennel site near Salem Chapel.

Also for information that the gate to Capel y Ddol cemetery has been opened. The stones still piled up on the ground.

Also that a pre-planning application has been sent to the National Park regarding cctv cameras on the Wenallt. We must now wait for any information (within 21 days) ETh stated that he had phoned the Park on 3 occasions, but had not received any response.

One of the Councilors asked why cctv were needed. And that many in the Village do not want this. Shouldn't there be a public meeting?

AH noted that a decision had been made and the decision could only be reversed in 6 months. So this stands.

Gwynfor Owen also stated his opinion regarding CCTV. At the beginning he was not in their favour. , but has now changed his mind. With all the cuts in the police service, something will certainly be needed.

He also noted that the most vandalized damage to public toilet properties was between Harlech and Bermo.

5. Parking near Plas Newydd - response from Iwan ap Trefor - yellow lines on the site. Passed to support this.

6. The tidying team has done a very good job removing trees and growth from the Mochras road river bank.

Meeting with Snowdonia Airoospace – trying to get a meeting at the Aerodrome on April 22.

Work to change electricity poles in the area - still continuing.

Report by Councillor Gwynfor Owen

That an increase of 5.2% is expected from Gwynedd Council for Tax. Gwynedd Council is one of the lowest increase for the year. And thus more burden on the departments.

We are also looking at what action people are taking with matters such as the former head teacher Foden, and that this never happens again. (abusing children in their care)

Any Other Matter Arising

Helen Johns - praised Gwynedd Council's work on clearing vegetation on the river wall, and bridge.

John Evans - sympathies with 2 families who have recently lost members of their families - Mr. Wilkes, and Charlotte Thomas.

Luise Vasey – random fly tipping and overgrowth on side of road.
